*Mr. Dupuis*—On Saturday next—INQUIRY OF MINISTRY—(No. 212)—Does Albert Vilandr , who occupies Building 124 at RCAF base St. Jean, where he deals in soft drinks, ice-cream, cigarettes, etc., also carry on the trade of the following items: watches and jewellery of all kinds, washing machines, frigidaires, bicycles, record players, and furniture?

*Mr. Regier*—On Saturday next—INQUIRY OF MINISTRY—(No. 213)—1. What was the total amount of estimated unpaid principal on marketable first mortgages held by Central Mortgage and Housing Corporation as of March 31, 1961?

2. What was the total amount of estimated unpaid principal on non-marketable first mortgages held by Central Mortgage and Housing Corporation as of March 31, 1961?

3. Of the unpaid principal of these marketable mortgages, what amounts called for what percentage of interest charges?
