The text of the Message and Recommendation of the Administrator pursuant to Standing Order 32(1) in relation to the foregoing Bill is as follows:

The Excellency the Administrator recommends to the House of Commons a measure to amend the Army Benevolent Fund Act to grant in the manner prescribed to the Administrator the Fund Board authority in relation to funds and monies in the Army Benevolent Fund, to establish a separate account in the Consolidated Revenue Fund for such segregated fund and provide for interest to be credited thereto semi-annually at a rate to be prescribed and, to provide for expenses of the Board to be reimbursed upon the assumption of the management of a fund.

Mr. Sharp for Mr. Buchanan, seconded by Mr. Drury,

His Excellency the Administrator, recommended to the House of Commons a measure to amend the Leases Replacement Act to provide for application to property, the right of the Government to the proceeds of which is appropriated to the Yukon Territory or to the Northwest Territories.

Mr. Lang seconded by Mr. Blais, by leave of the House, introduced Bill C-4, An Act to provide for payments in respect of work performed and sold in Canada for human consumption in Canada, which was read the first time and ordered to be printed and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

The text of the Message and Recommendation of the Administrator pursuant to Standing Order 32(1) in relation to the foregoing Bill is as follows:
