Coins I Do Not Buy.

Flying eagle Cents of 1857 and 1858.

Three Cents, nickel, excepting 1877. (Do not mistake nickel for silver).

Five Cents, 1883, without the word "CENTS."

Quarter Dollars of 1853, with arrow heads at sides of date,

Half Dollars of 1853, as last.

Half Dollars of 1861.

Columbian Half Dollars of either 1892 or 1893.

Dollars of 1878 with either seven or eight feathers in the eagle's tail.

Spanish Coins of the value of $\frac{1}{2}$, 1, 2, 4 and 8 Reales are not wanted, except at metal value, even though dating back 200 years.
