

## THE SENATE OF CANADA.

### BILL O<sup>3</sup>.

An Act respecting The Western Canada Accident and Guarantee Insurance Company.

**W**HEREAS the Western Canada Accident and Guarantee Insurance Company has by its petition represented that it is incorporated by chapter 77 of the statutes of Manitoba of 1908, and amendments thereto, and has 5 prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: There fore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

10 **1.** The Western Canada Accident and Guarantee Insurance Company as now organized and constituted under the statutes mentioned in the preamble, and hereinafter called "the Manitoba Company", is hereby constituted a body corporate and politic within the legislative authority of 15 the Parliament of Canada under the name of "The Western Canada Accident and Guarantee Insurance Company" hereinafter called "the Company"; and this Act shall apply to the Manitoba Company and its business, instead of the statutes mentioned in the preamble: Provided that 20 nothing herein shall affect anything done or any liability incurred by the Manitoba Company up to the time this Act goes into effect as hereinafter provided, to all of which liabilities the Company shall be subject.

**2.** The capital stock of the Company shall be one million 25 dollars.
