Principal Transactions of the *Last War*
between the *English* and *French* in
North America.



THE two first Objects of the War in *North America* were *Nova Scotia* or *Acadie*, and the Island of *Cape Breton*: against the former of these the *French*, soon after the Declaration of War in *Europe*, made three Attempts; in the first of which they surprized the Island of *Canso*, burnt its Forts and other Buildings, destroyed the Fishery there, and carried the Garrison Prisoners to *Louisbourg*; and in the two last reduced *Annapolis Royal*, the principal Fort and ancient Metropolis of the Province, to great Extremities: In the Year following the Colonies of *New England* prosecuted an Expedition against *Cape Breton*; in which they took it, and brought the Inhabitants of the Island of *St.*
