I have the honor to state that in accordance with the desire expressed in your telegram of the 20th ultimo, Mr. Assistant Commissioner Reed, after sending Pin-pot and his followers back to their respective Reserves, agreed with the Chief that he and his Headmen accompanied by an official of the Department might go in search of another Reserve owing to the apparent dissatisfaction relative to the one now held by them.
