The Exhibition was opened as usual with an evening assembly of members and honorary members, which was largely attended.

His Excellency the Governor-General and Lady Lansdowne came from Ottawa for the occasion, and also lent some valuable pictures, which added to the interest of the Exhibition.

His Excellency being on the eve of his departure from Canada to take the position of Governor-General of India, was presented with a farewell address by the Academy, a fitting tribute to the valuable service he had rendered to the cause of art and to the interest of our Society during his residence in the Dominion.

The Exhibition was opened to the public on the following day, 8th of May, and remained open for three weeks. It showed some of the strongest work that has yet been exhibited by members of the Academy.

The annual meeting was held on 8th May. All the officers were unanimously re-elected and the council for the year declared.

The next meeting and exhibition will be held in Ottawa, in the National Gallery, and will be opened by His Excellency Lord Stanley, Governor-General and Patron of the Academy.

The evening assembly of members, honorary members and their families, at which His Excellency will preside, is to take place on the March, and the annual meeting of members on the following day.
