Moved by the Rev. Dr. LEITCH; seconded by the Rev. EDWARD SULLIVAN, A.B.:

2. That the past successes of Bible circulation in many lands, the new openings which are still presented for the entrance of the Word of Life, and various events in providence in connexion with the Bible,—the inspired Word of God, and the supreme and infallible rule of faith and life, should more and more unite all true-hearted Christians in vindicating the authority of the Scriptures, and promoting their circulation among all the families of the earth.
