ARTICLE I.

NAME.

This Society shall be called THE TORONTO CHILDREN'S AID SOCIETY.

ARTICLE II.

OBJECTS.

Its object shall be to care for and protect neglected children; to secure the enactment and enforcement of laws relating to neglected children or juvenile offenders; to provide free summer excursions, temporary residence in the country, and other means for benefiting neglected children; and generally to advocate their claims upon public sympathy and support.

ARTICLE III.

MEMBERSHIP.

Any person paying the sum of One Dollar annually shall be deemed a member of the Society, and persons paying at any one time the sum of Fifty Dollars shall be eligible for life membership; or the Board may appoint for valuable services rendered or other sufficient cause, persons to a life membership.

ARTICLE IV.

OFFICERS.

The Officers of the Society shall consist of a President, Four Vice-Presidents, a Treasurer, a Secretary and a Council composed of ten ladies and ten gentlemen—to be elected at the annual meeting of the Society in each year, who shall constitute the Board of Management and who shall hold Office till their successors are appointed.

ARTICLE V.

VACANCIES.

Vacancies occurring during the year may be filled by the Board of Management.
