This work would necessarily
be done when the subdivision is
made and as the Clandetoye
settlers ~~to~~ are very anxious to be
able to use a road through the
Reserve to Selkirk, I think it would
be advisable to put the survey of
this part of the Reserve on your
list as one of the first to be attended to.
