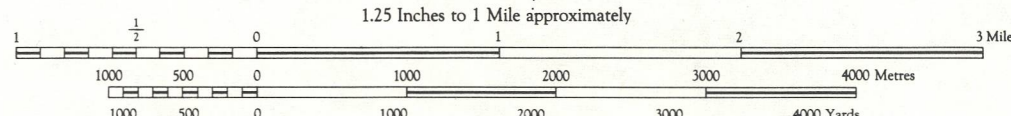


MAGNETIC DECLINATION $5^{\circ} 08' \text{ EAST}$
