BALTIMORE, Md., April 23—The principal speaker at the celebration of the 400th anniversary of the birth of John Calvin, was Ambasador Bryce, of Great Britain,

Mr. Bryce observed that he was not going to say anything about Calvin's theology and very little about his life, but would merely characterize in precise terms his historical position and the causes which had given him so great an influence upon the world.
