With reference to your letter of the 4th. ult. regarding cutting rights on a certain piece of land comprising 50 acres, as shown on plan made by Otto Schierbeck P.L.S., the Department accepts your offer for the purchase of these rights, and a cheque for the sum of \$500 has gone forward to you under separate cover.

It is the understanding that the Indians of the Cambridge Reserve have the privilege of cutting timber on this land for fuel purposes, during a period of five years dating from Aug. 1st. 1934.
