### UNOFFICINAL FORMULAS.

The Committee on Unofficinal Formulas, appointed by the American Pharmaceutical Association, presented, through the chairman, Mr. J. F. Hancock, the following report embracing formulas for preparations not embraced in the last edition of the U. S. P., but which by their recognition by the Association may be regarded as <sup>supplementary</sup> to that compilation :--

#### Chlorate Mixture.

Take of Chlorate of Potassium, in fine powder,..60 grs.Bicarbonate of Sodium,.....Mix them.......

Chlorodyne, Liquor Chloroform, Compound.

(P. Squire's Formula.)

|      | Svrup                        | • | $17\frac{1}{2}$ fluid ounces. |
|      | Hydrocvanic Acid. 2 per cent | • | 2  fluid ounces               |

Directions.—Dissolve the morphia and oil of peppermint in the alcohol; mix the chloroform and ether with this solution. Mix the bicorice with the syrup and add the molasses. Shake these two mixtures well together, and lastly add the hydrocyanic acid, and again shake well.
