From 30th April to 1st August, i.e., in May, June, and July, by any other manner of Fishing.

In New Brunswick from 1st March to 15th September,

by Fly-Surface-Fishing.

From 1st of March to 15th Augustboth days inclusive, by any other means.

Foul or unclean Salmon at no time to be caught.

Salmon Fry, Parr and Smolt not to be caught; and no Salmon or Grilse, to be taken of less than 3 lbs. weight—if taken by accident to be released.

II. Trout.—Trout (or Lunge) may be taken in the months of January, February, March, April, May, June, July, August and September, and on first day of October. This applies to Speckled Trout also in the Province of Quebec.

In Ontario Speckled Trout can only be taken in May, June, July, August and September.

In lake Memphramagog Trout or Lunge may be taken in every month except October and November.

Trout is only to be taken by angling by hand with hook and line, except in tidal waters, and in Ontario this restriction only applies to Speckled Trout.

III. White Fish.—May be taken all the year by angling except except from 19th November to 1st December.

Gill Nets for Salmon-trout or White Fish to have meshes of at least 5 inches extension measure, and Seines for White Fish to have meshes of not less than 4 inches.

IV. Bass, Pickerel, Doré or Maskinongé.—May be taken at any time in the Province of Quebec except from 15th April to 24th May; and in Ontario except from 15th April to 1st May.
