An Act to amend the Act to alter and amend the Act regulating the practice of the County Courts in Upper Canada, and to extend the jurisdiction thereof.

[Assented to 1st July, 1856.]

WHEREAS the large number of cases usually entered for trial Preamble. at the Assizes for the United Counties of York and Peel render it difficult to provide for the despatch of business as at present conducted: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

I.
