- 16. The officer or person to whom any order or warrant is Execution of addressed under the foregoing provisions shall forthwith re-warrant. move the person named thereon from the said lands, and in the execution of the said order or warrant shall have all the 5 powers, rights, immunities and privileges enjoyed by a sheriff, constable or other peace officer in the execution of his duty.
- 17. Any person remaining upon Dominion lands after Penalty for having been ordered to vacate them, or returning thereto after disobeying having vacated them in obedience to a summons, or after etc.

  10 having been removed therefrom under an order or warrant as aforesaid, shall, upon summary conviction thereof before a judge, stipendiary or police magistrate or two or more justices of the peace, be liable to a fine of not less than twenty dollars and not more than one hundred dollars.
