12. At Ottawa, October 12th, 1935
As reported in THE OTTAWA CITIZEN, OCTOBER 14, 1935

"I will tell you about the relief camps. When the Liberal party comes back into power the unfortunates in those camps will be made to feel that they are human beings like everyone else, not lost souls placed out of the way in remote places. An agency such as the Department of National Defence, a department established solely for the administration of military affairs and warfare, will not be placed in charge of these men!"
