Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 12th ultimo, relative to the matter of the payment made to the Metlakatla Indians for land purchased ~~by~~ by the Grand Trunk Pacific Railway Company, and enclosing a letter and statement on the subject from Agent Morrow; and in reply I beg to say that when the final payment is made Mr Morrow should forward a statement ^{duplicate} (with receipts) giving the names of the Indians paid and the amount received by each. The cheques which he issues on the Bank of Commerce against the amount on deposit should also be forwarded to the Department after they have been paid by the bank and are returned to him.
