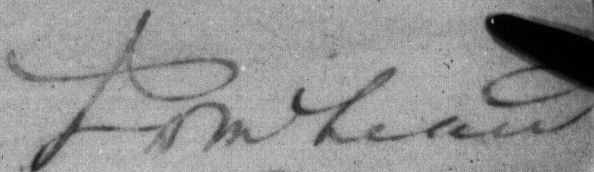
Ottawa, January 7, 1913.

Sir,-

The return for the December quarter from the Batchewana Bay School shows that the Christmas holidays were taken from the 12th to the 31st of December.

The Department was not aware of this when the advance of \$50.00 was made to Miss Mallon and she has been consequently overpaid. The school should not have been closed according to the regulations till December 20th and the Department would like to know why it was closed on the 12th instead of on the date provided for. Assuming that the school was opened by Miss Mallon on November 15th she could only have taught eighteen days to December 12th and the salary due for that period would have been \$36.00 instead of \$50.00. The Department would like to have some explanation in regard to this as soon as possible.
