

Ottawa, November 9, 1915.


Rev. Sir,-

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 2nd instant in reference to your claim that a deduction of \$300.00 was made from the grant to the Kenora Boarding School for the quarter ended September 30th, last, and also deducted from the cheque sent you in payment of men's wages.

With reference to the quarterly grant I beg to say that there was no deduction made from the grant to this school for the September quarter. The grant is allowed your school for fifty pupils only and the full grant for this number was paid, viz.- \$1562.50. The only deduction made was the \$300.00 advanced on account of men's wages.

An advance of \$500.00 on the December quarters earnings of your school has been sent you.
