



Sir,-

Referring to your letter of the 2nd instant, in which you suggest the purchase of a motor tractor and threshing outfit, etc., for Enoch and Wabamun (Paul) Reserves, I beg to say that recently Mr. Race wrote to the Department in regard to the introduction of traction power on those reserves, with a view to increasing the crop acreage thereon. Copy of his letter in the matter was sent to Commissioner Graham, at Balcarres, for consideration, and it is thought that you will probably hear from the latter in this matter at an early date. Your recommendation will be considered when Commission Graham has also made report.
