10. It might be arranged with some of the provinces, even Quebec, to propose the enactment of a Canadian Constitution with the power to amend in Canada and complete safeguards respecting minority questions. Two-thirds of the B.N.A. Act is "spent".

11. As soon as some such plan as the foregoing is decided on, it would probably be advisable to have informal and confidential discussions with Messrs. Garson and Godbout to discuss the general scheme and the best way to approach it and time the various steps.
