ENEMY FLEW 280 SORTIES IN HEAVY BOMBING AND STRAPPING
ATTACKS BRITISH POSITIONS LEROS PRIOR TO ITS CAPITULATION. U S
HEAVIES DROPPED 60 TONS ELEUSIS AIRFIELD AND MEDIUMS DROPPED 40 TONS
KALAMAKI AIRFIELD (BOTH ATHENS). ALLIED FIGHTERS BOMBED AND
STRAPPED OIL STORAGE DEPOT AT DURAZZO. HEAVY WEATHER HAMPERED AIR
OPERATIONS IN BATTLE AREA.
