I had access to the Sgt's quarters, I did not know the Sgt had liquor in his room, there was no light in the hall when the accused (Sullivan) made his first trip to the house, the first time the accused (Sullivan) came he had a flashlight and he shone it on his face and that is how I can identify him, on his second visit the living room door was open and from the light that came thru I could identify the accused (Sullivan) I could see the accused had a moustache, I saw the soldier I have identified clearly on other occasions. I did not see the soldier I have identified as being Sullivan with a bottle.
