

The light in the house at this time was from a small oil lamp. The electric lights came on at eight o'clock. The electricity came on approx 15 min after the accused (Sullivan) left for the second time.

Cross Examined

The Sgt's quarters were on the third and top floor of the house. A person would have to climb 2 flights of stairs to get to this room. The other soldiers billeted in the house had a room opposite that occupied by Sgt Carlouke. The BSM & the Sgt seemed very friendly, the BSM left the house at 1800 hrs 14 Feb 45 and came home after 2200 hrs. we could always see someone enter the house, from the living room, we could see anyone come in and start up stairs. I had access to the Sgt's quarters, I did not know the Sgt had liquor in his room, there was no light in the hall when the accused (Sullivan) made his first trip to the house, the first time the accused (Sullivan) came he had a flashlight and he shone it on his face and that is how I can identify him, on his second visit the living room door was open and from the light that came thru I could identify the accused (Sullivan) I could see the accused had a moustache, I saw the soldier I have identified clearly on both occasions. I did not see the soldier I have identified as Sgt Sullivan with a bottle
