CHAPTER XV.

By-Law to provide for the Improvement of that part of the London Road from Flanagan's Corner to the Town Line of London.

Whereas the state of that part of the London Road from Flanagan's Corner to the Town Line of London, is at certain seasons in an almost impassable state:

Be it enacted, by the Warden and Municipal Council of the District of Huron, in pursuance of the Act 4th and 5th Victoria, chapter 10, and the Act 9th Victoria, chapter 40, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the sum of One Hundred and Forty Pounds currency be, and is hereby granted, to improve the said portion of the said London Road, &c.; to drain and grade the same. The said sum of One Hundred and Forty Pounds currency to be taken into consideration as part of the £7000 voted for the London Road.
