BE it enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That the Act, passed in the Third year of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, entitled, an Act in amendment of the Act for the settlement of the Poor in the several Townships within this Province, and every matter, clause and thing, therein contained, shall be continued, and the same are hereby continued for one year, and from thence to the end of the then next Session of the General Assembly.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That the Act made and passed in the third year of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the Fourth, entitled, An Act for consolidating and reducing into one Act, all the Acts heretofore made relating to Trespasses, except so far as the same is or may be altered or amended by the several Acts hereinafter mentioned, also the Act passed in the fourth and fifth year of His said late Majesty's Reign, to alter, amend, and continue the said Act, also the Act passed in the ninth year of His said late Majesty's Reign, to alter and continue the said Acts, also the Act passed in the second year of the Reign of His late Majesty, King William the Fourth, to amend and continue the said Acts, and also the Act made and passed in the third year of the Reign of His said late Majesty, King William the Fourth, entitled, An Act in further amendment of the Acts relating to trespasses, and every matter, clause, and thing, in the said Acts contained, except as aforesaid, shall be continued, and the same are hereby severally and respectively continued for three years, and from thence to the end of the then next Session of the General Assembly.
