SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH WEST LAND REGULATIONS WEST LAND REGULATIONS

The sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter-section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. Apparent must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any Dominion Lands Agency (but not Sub-Agency), on certain conditions.

Duties—Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homestender may live within A homestender may live within miles of his homestend on a farm of ast 80 acres, on certain conditions at legst 80 acres, on certain conditions at legst 80 acres, on certain conditions A babinable house is required except where residence is performed in the wicinity.

Live stock may be substituted for cultivation under certain conditions.

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section alongside his homestead. Price \$2.00 per acre.
