FREE-FOR-ALL WON BY

SINGLE G. AT RANDALL

Defeated Formidable Field of Pacers—Sets Record.

NORTH RANDALL, Cleveland, July 8.—Pacing the fastest time of the year, Single G. owned by W. B. Barefoot, Cambridge City, Ind., defeated one of the most formidable fields of pacers in training today in the free-for-all pace sweepstakes, the feature of the get-away grand circuit, at the Cleveland track. His victory came in straight heats.

Ed. Allen took the veteran out in front early in each mile and he was never headed. He paced the first mile in 2:01 3-4, and the second in 2:02 1-4, winning easily. The last quarter of the final heat was paced in 29 seconds. Had Single G. been pushed there is little doubt that this time would have been faster. The time for the two miles not only is the fastest pace record, but also beats that of the trotters for the season. Blackburn took the second division of the 2:02 pace in straight heats.

Donzo captured second money by virtue of his victory in the third after Blackburn had been ruled out. Gov. Durbin Jr., was raced under protest pending establishment of his identity. He finished third in the first mile, second in the next and seventh in the final after setting the pace to the end of the race. The event was won by Peter Bell, which changed hands several days ago for \$8,000. Because of withdrawals and others being distanced earlier, Wiggins, the World's Best Trotter, was the only starter in the final heat.

Practically all of the stakes leave tonight or tomorrow for Toledo.
