MAJESTIC DRAMA
DRAWS BIG HOUSE"Smooth As Silk" Presented
by Grew Players This
Week Delights Audience.

If "Smooth as Silk," the drama of the underworld, presented at the Majestic Theatre by the William A. With this information presented to the audience during the first act, the remainder of the performance reveals

"Silk" Ulane, so named because of his smooth manners, at his best, in an effort to fulfill his obligation for liberty, master minds are pitted against him, but "Silk," to the delight of the audience, wins out, by clever work, which is a credit to the playwright responsible.

Robert Hyman, in the stellar role of "Silk," surpasses his previous good work in this city, and proves himself a master in his chosen profession. However, his honors are ended

tion liable to payment of taxes

under The Corporation Tax Act

shall without notice or demand

be liable to make out, verify and

deliver to the Provincial Sec-

retary on or before the 8th day

of February each year, a de-

tailed statement or return con-

taining certain information as of

the 31st day of December next

preceding.

If a corporation makes default in

complying with the above, such

corporation shall be liable to a penalty

under Section 135 of The Ontario Com-
