Creameries should start up all over the land, and in a short time not only the Canadian trade should be supplied but there should be a handsome quantity to send to the British market. It will pay to send good butter there. The freight amounts to less than a cent a pound and good Canadian, in sufficient quantity, ought to bring between 25 and 30 cents a pound there. The technical education is the first thing necessary. It was not improvement in the cows so nuch as knowledge of how to make and handle the product of the cheese factories that has brought the cheese industry forward so rapidly. Prof. Robertson of Guelph and those already reaping the benefits of creamery patronage, will no doubt be ready to give all information at their disposal as to the methods to be adopted to produce good creamery butter. 
