THE fourth of July was a day of mourning for the parish. The Fathers and the parishioners gathered together, after solemn obsequies, around the body of the late M^{rs} François Racine (Anastasic Huot), to follow her remains to her last home. The solicitude of the parishioners and the sorrow depicted on every countenance, showed how she was esteemed by all who knew her. She was carried away unexpectedly by an illness, which inspired fear but too late: she died from heart disease. Her body was laid to rest next to that of her lamented husband, and of her venerable Father-in-law M^r Michel Racine, who preceded her by a few months only.
