There are eight Divinity Scholarships of the annual value of \$160, tenable for three years. Besides these there are: One Binney Exhibition (\$50); Three STEVENSON Science Scholarships (\$60.: One McCawley Hebrew Prize (\$86); One Cogswell Scholarship (\$120), open for Candidates for Holy Orders; One McCawley Testimonial Scholarship (\$38); One Akins Historical Prize (\$30); One Almon Welsford Testamonial (\$24); One Haliburron Prize (\$20); One Cogswell Cricket prize. The necessary sepenses of Board, Rooms, &c., average \$15 per annum. Nominated students do not pay tuition fees. These nominations fity in number, ore open to all Matriculated Students, and are worth about \$30 for the three years course. All Matriculated Students are required to reside in College unless specially exempted. The Professor's reside within the limits of the University grounds.
