Mr. Secretary of State:

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated September 25, 1990, concerning the Convention of October 23, 1954 on the presence of foreign forces in the Federal Republic of Germany, the French text of which reads as follows:

I have the honour to inform you that the Government of the Kingdom of Belgium accepts the contents of your letter. Consequently your letter, this reply and the replies of the Ambassador of Canada, the Ambassador of the United States of America, the Ambassador of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Ambassador of the Kingdom of the Netherlands shall constitute an agreement between our governments.
