University-to-university agreement for up to two students from all departments. Students interested in the exchange program are expected to have at least second year standing (in Germany this equals a successful "Vordiplom" or "Zwischenprüfung"). German exchange students are expected to score at least 575 points in the TOEFL Test.

Participants from Osnabrück are screened and selected by a committee of representatives of the departments (Sciences, Law and Humanities) and from the "Akademisches Auslandsamt". Canadian students participating in the exchange program are selected by a similar committee.

There is a tuition waiver and the participants remain enrolled at their home university and pay their usual tuition fees at their home university. University personnel of the host university will assist exchange students in finding suitable accommodation. German students have to purchase medical insurance at the University of Victoria. Students are responsible for residence and other costs.

The participants enroll at the host university as full-time students for one academic year. Academic credits obtained at the host university may be transferred back to the home university.
