MEMORANDUM December 17th, 1920. To-day at the Mount Royal Club after lunch I discussed with Mr. A. D. MacTier, Colonel Herbert Molson and Major Haywood the matter of the attached Memoranda. I am convinced that the Directors of the Montreal General Hospital will not agree to the proposal as to the manner in which the constitution of the Nominating Body is arrived at. Their objections are:-(1) If put into practice now it means the appointment of Dr. Hutchison, and they will not have Dr. Hutchison. They are afraid that in a few years all the Professors of McGill University will be members of the staff of the Royal Victoria Hospital and that the representation of the Montreal General would be nil.
