

II. PRESBYTERY OF ROCK LAKE.—That the Presbytery of Rock Lake shall be bounded on the south by the international boundary-line, extending from the western boundary of the Province of Manitoba eastward to the first principal meridian; on the east by the western boundary of the Presbytery of Winnipeg; on the north by the dividing line between townships seven and eight, extending from the first principal meridian to the western side of range seven, and the dividing line between townships six and seven, extending from the western side of range seven to the western side of range eleven, and by the dividing line between townships five and six, extending from the western side of range eleven to the western boundary of the Province; on the west by the western side of township seven, range seven, to the western side of township six, range eleven, and by the western boundary of the Province.

2. SYNOD, FIRST MEETING, ETC.

(a) The General Assembly on the recommendation of the Committee appointed the Synod of Manitoba and the North-West Territories to meet in Knox Church, Winnipeg, on the sixteenth day of July, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-four (16th July, 1884,) and that Professor Bryce be the Moderator of said Synod till his successor be duly elected; and that the records of the Presbytery of Manitoba be the property of the Synod. The Synod shall, at said meeting, appoint the first Moderators of the several Presbyteries and fix the times and places of their first meetings.
