By-laws enacted pursuant to resolution of delegates do not require confirmation. 10. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or in the hereinbefore recited statutes or in Part III of *The Companies Act, 1934*, whenever by this Act or any of the hereinbefore recited statutes the directors are authorized to enact a by-law in accordance with the terms of a resolution adopted or approved by the delegates or a majority or a specified majority or proportion of the delegates present at a general or special meeting, any by-law enacted by the directors in accordance with the terms of any such resolution shall not require to be confirmed by the share- 10 holders or delegates.
