Artificial Teeth Without Plates.

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If but four firm roots still remain in the jaw in proper position, we can attach an entire set of teeth to these roots, and restore the mouth to its original usefulness and beauty without the use of a plate.

Models showing how the Tooth-Crown and Bridgework are attached to the Teeth.

Extraction Avoided.



Comparatively Painless.

A.—Mouth with Roots prepared and Teeth ready to be attached to roots. **B.**—Bridgework Artificial Teeth. **C.**—Represents the Teeth firmly and permanently cemented to the Roots. One can masticate on these Teeth the same as upon natural Teeth. **D.**—Gold crown put on a broken down molar root, and the masticating surface restored. **E.**—Root prepared for crown. **F.**—Porcelain crown for attachment to root of Front Tooth which has been broken off, and crown restored without the use of a plate. **G.**—Root prepared for crown.
