PERSONS ELIGIBLE FOR RELIEF OR ADMISSION 12.TO THE HOUSE.

- 1. Orphans.
- 2. Deserted Children.
- 3. Children of persons, who, from poverty or sickness, are unable to support them.
- 4. Persons whose age and infirmities render them unable to provide for themselves; and who have no friends able and willing to support them.
- 5. Patients discharged incurable from the General Hospital, or in so weak a state of health a to unfit them for earning their own living.

It being considered indispensible that previous to any patient being sent to the House, a certificate in writing, stating the name, age, and disorder of the individual, shall be sent to this Institution, at least three days previously, in order to afford the Medical Officers of this Charity an opportunity to report if the case is one which they consider should be received.

- 1. Old and infirm persons.
