also, that the said statutes, rules, and ordinances, shall be subject to the approbation of the said Visitor of our said College for the time being: And shall be forthwith transmitted to the said Visitor for that purpose: And that in case the said Visitor shall for Us, and on our behalf in writing, signify his disapprobation thereof within two years of the time of their being so made and framed, the same or such part thereof as shall be so disapproved of by the said Visitor, shall, from the time of such disapprobation being made known to the said Chancellor of our said College, be utterly void and of no effect, but otherwise shall be, and remain in full force and virtue.

Provided, nevertheless, and we do hereby expressly save and reserve to Us, our heirs and successors, the power of reviewing, confirming, or reversing by any order or orders, to be by Us or them made in our or their Privy Council, all or any of
