NORTH BAY, Oct. 9.-The grand jury found Gordon Hunter of Haileybury guilty of manslaughter in the death of Ed Boylan from injuries re-ceived while being ejected from the Vendome Hotel at Haileybury last

The defence sought to prove that Boylan was abusive and acted offen-sively in the hotel, that Hunter was carrying out his instructions in maintaining out his instructions in maintaining order, and that Boylan was injured by falling down the steps of the hotel, no undue violence being used in his ejection.

Judge Riddell's charge to the jury was unfavorable to the prisoner. Upon being asked if he had anything to say, he stated to the court that

Hunter, who is very popular in Halleybury and a quiet, well-behaved man, feels his position keenly, and the verdict was a great surprise and shock to him, as well as his mother, wife and little daughter, who were present at the trial.
