WHERE IS GEN. PANDO? The Spanish General in Cuba Has Not Been Heard From and There is Anxiety About Him.

Havana, Dec. 24.-Captain-General Blanco has called to the Spanish Ministers at Washington, Senor Dupuy de Lome, informing him that Americans have authority to send supplies to the reconcentrados of the island without paying customs duty.

General Pando, the Spanish commander-in-chief in the East, who landed recently on the south coast of Santiago de Cuba with an escort, in order, according to the official report, to reconnoitre that part of the island has not been heard from for five days. St. John's, Nfld., Dec. 24.-The supporters of the Whitewrite Party at the Harbor Grace are hoping to embarrass the Government of Sir James Walter in connection with the projected purchase of the Local Orange Association next Sunday. Sir Herbert Murray, the Governor, has issued a proclamation forbidding the procession, because in 1883, the last time the parade occurred, several persons were killed.

The latest news from the herring fishery in Placentia Bay shows a great success in the American fishing fleet. Seventeen Gloucester vessels have sailed with full cargoes, and 37 are now engaged in the fishery, and over 50,000 barrels of herring are now on shore.
