LARGE USERS OF WATER OPPOSED TO NEW RATES

Deputation of Manufacturers, Brewers and Others Wait on Committee - Gas Complaints

A deputation representing Toronto nanufacturers, brewers, distillers and invited pork-packers appeared before the civic water rates committee yesterday to protest against the proposed increase in water rates. The plan under con-sideration is to raise the rates of the manufacturers, tanners and pork packers from 5c to 7c per 1000 gallons; to brewers and distillers from 7c to 10c per 1000 gallons. The laundrymen now pay 15c per 1000 gallons, and a deputation asked that they be given the same rate as manufacturers.

C. E. Phillips for the manufacturers said that in Detroit manufacturers

rate was only 2 1-4c, and in Buffalo 2c. The chairman, Controller Harrison, replied that in Detroit manufacturers were charged \$1.75 for the first 20,000
