


Halifax, at nine o'clock ; on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday mornings for Kentville, Wolfville and Annapolis immediately after the arrival of the Stage from Halifax.

Leave Kentville, on Monday, Wednesday and Friday mornings for Halifax and for Annapolis at six o'clock.

Leave Annapolis, on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday mornings for Kentville, Wolfville, Windsor and Halifax, at six o'clock.

 This arrangement has reference only to Summer—it is generally varied during the winter months.

The EASTERN STAGE COACHES (carrying H M Mails), run three times in the week from Halifax to Pictou, and *vice versa*. Leave Halifax and Pictou, on Monday, Wednesday and Friday mornings.

A Stage Coach runs between Amherst, (Co'y of Cumberland) and St. John, N.B.

The Parrsboro' Packet runs to Windsor and Horton every week, from the 1st of April till Christmas; leaves Parrsboro' on Tuesday, immediately after the arrival of the Royal Western Mail Coach; leaves Parrsboro' on Thursday for Horton, and from thence for Parrsboro', the first high water at or after 8 o'clock on Friday morning. *Passengers who wish to cross from Parrsboro' should be at Partridge Island the evening previous to the Packet's sailing.*
