A walk down Lansdowne Avenue cannot fail to interest you. The treatment of the street area itself is unique and represents a combination of beauty and utility which is instantly appreciated. The roadway has been narrowed down to the minimum width required by wheeled traffic, thus keeping the dust producing area of the street as small as possible. Grass plots 18 feet wide lie between the roadway and sidewalks. As the traffic demands a wider roadway the grass plots will be narrowed. Down the centre of each grass plot is a row of shade trees.

On each side of Lansdowne Avenue are comfortable self-contained and two family homes with lawn in front and garden in rear. The interior plans and exterior designs of these dwellings represent standards of convenience and beauty too often lacking in St. John homes.

A Busy Place

Other houses are in various stages of construction, employing a small army of masons, carpenters, plumbers, painters, etc. Further out a large crew of men is engaged in extending the city water and sewer service out Lansdowne Avenue, across Wellesley Street to Dufferin Avenue and in Dufferin Avenue to Dufferin School. Following these are men and teams engaged in street grading and road making.
