HOME BANK ABSORBS INTERNATIONALE

(Montreal Shareholders)

Apart from a few minor details, the absorption of the Internationale Bank of Canada by the Home Bank of Montreal has been completed. This makes another in the rapidly growing list of bank mergers which has taken place during recent years, and also marks the passing from Montreal to Toronto of the headquarters of another bank.

The Internationale Bank which is being taken over, commenced business less than a year ago, with Sir Rudolph Forget as President, and J. Godfrey Bell as General Manager. Its authorized capital was \$10,000,000, of which, however, only \$1,300,000 had been paid up. The bank has had a somewhat checkered experience during its short career. Sir Rudolph Forget as president, became identified with several propositions which turned out disastrously in a financial sense. Among these were the Quebec Railway, Light, Heat & Power Company which passed its dividend during the year, the Quebec and Saguenay Railway, which failed to pay its construction charges, and the Eastern Telephone Company, which passed its dividend during the year.

The Home Bank is one of the most progressive and carefully managed of the smaller banks in Canada. It was organized first as the Home Loan & Savings Company, later developing into a bank. It has a considerable number of branches scattered throughout Ontario and the west, but has none in Quebec. Its connection with the Internationale Bank will therefore strengthen its position in the province.

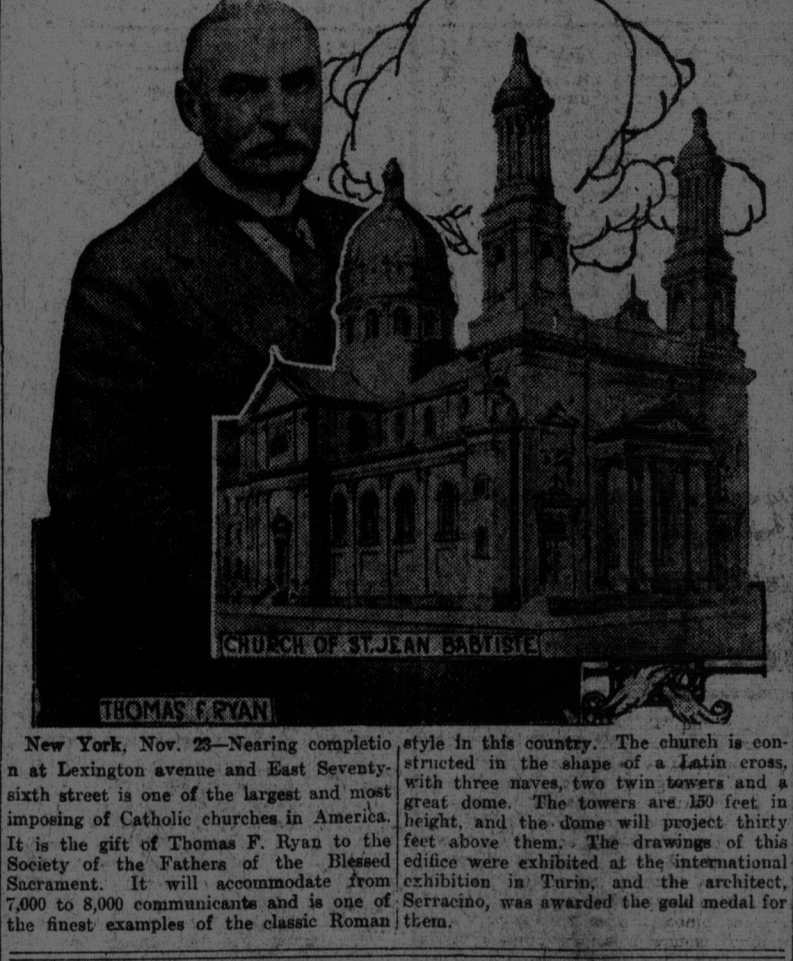

THOMAS F. RYAN BUILDS GREAT CHURCH FOR CATHOLIC FATHERS

New York, Nov. 23.—Nearing completion at Lexington Avenue and East Seventy-sixth street is one of the largest and most imposing Catholic churches in America. It is the gift of Thomas F. Ryan to the Society of the Fathers of the Blessed Sacrament. It will accommodate from 7,000 to 8,000 worshippers and is one of the finest examples of the classic Roman style in this country. The church is constructed in the shape of a Latin cross, with three naves, two twin towers and a great dome. The towers are 150 feet high, and the dome will project thirty feet above them. The drawings of the edifice were exhibited at the international exhibition in Turin, and the architect, S. G. S. S. was awarded the gold medal for them.

IN PERIL ON THE THRONE

Records of Attempts Made to Assassinate Reigning Monarchs

Although at the time Grogan's tramping on the brink of a war which threatened, directly or indirectly to involve the whole continent, public attention was diverted, during the middle of the present month, from the theatre of international hostilities, to Rome, Italy was herself engaged in war with Turkey, but not that kind of war claimed the notice of the world. The war was that waged by a man against another man. Antonio D'Alba was on trial for having attempted to assassinate Victor Emmanuel III, King of Italy.

It was a strange and unusual picture, frequently in such a case the culprit is not exhibited to the public; his offence is not investigated in the hearing of the people. To familiarize the lawless by a sight of violence against the monarchy is to deprive legal state and sanctity of one of its traditional barriers. So, in the thought of the day, it was held that the offender should be hurried swiftly from sight into an obscure cell in a state prison and there death with in secret had been in the full light of day, we have had the misadventure on trial, with counsel pleading for the one whose name is the subject of the man upon whom the attack was made, and counsel pleading on the other hand, for the man against whose neck the sword was being drawn.

The trial was instructive and thrilling, and the fairness meted out to the murderer-by-intent certainly increases our respect for Italian justice methods. But it revealed great weakness in the scheme by which King Victor is guarded. He is much more at danger at the present time than he was when he was left to his own devices and unprotected on the day that D'Alba made his attack. After all the warnings they had had, the Italian authorities had merely decreed that the police on guard should be on their feet, and not for affectively buttressing the throne. The consequence was that the assassin, avowedly struck at the street uncontrolled, D'Alba was surrounded by them. They thought he was approaching, the question was whether a mine had been already laid or infernal machine deposited. It was impossible to upset the entire visit; the king must arrive—All that could be done was to have the royal train shunted into a siding and kept there for some hours while every foot of the line into the city was investigated.

Furious indignation possessed every right-minded man and woman of the nation at this double attempt to take the life of the sovereign, and the extreme alarm created made it almost incredible that a succeeding incident could have happened. But the feat of another ruffian as now a matter of history, and as such it may be treated. Only four months had elapsed after the Ancona sensation, when the proprietor of a cinematograph show applied for permission to give a performance at the Palazzo Reale, where the royal family were in residence. URGES TEACHING OF RELIGION IN SCHOOLS

Ottawa, Nov. 22.—We have suffered much as a people from denominational divisions and we have allowed these to prevent the teaching of religion in our schools. In the very nature of religion we have crippled religion.

In these words, Rev. Principal D. M. Gordon, of Queens University, before a large audience in the Normal school summarized a strong plea for religion in the common schools. Important, in view of the present agitation in regard to public and separate schools, and the teachings of religion by the latter, Dr. Gordon's address caused much interested comment.

"It was most important that some place should be found for Bible instruction in school life. The day in the public school should start with the recital of the Lord's Prayer and there should be Bible reading and the memorization of passages from the scriptures. Of the educational value of scripture reading there was no better example than Sir Wilfrid Laurier, with his apt use of Biblical quotations.
