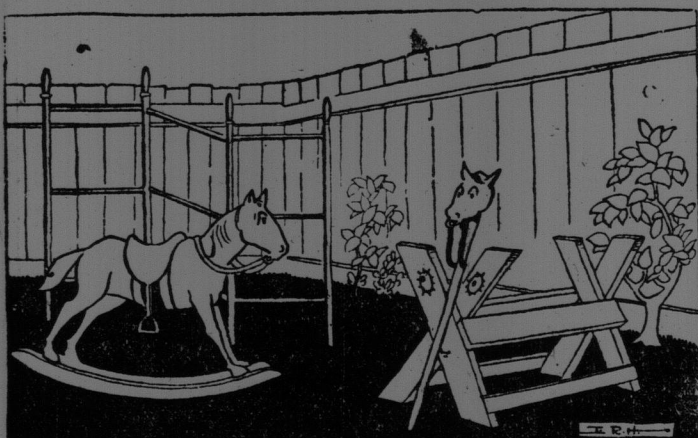

Shediac Historian May Also Get Figure-head of Chesapeake

Amherst, March 28.—A letter received here by C. H. Carter, manager of the Bank of Montreal, from Dr. J. Clarence Webster, of Shediac, now in London, states that he is making special efforts to secure old cannon to be placed on the ancient forts at Louisburg, Annapolis, and Beauséjour, near Amherst. At the same time, Dr. Webster remarked that he was planning upon the figure head of the historic warship Chesapeake to be presented to the city of Halifax, while there were possibilities that he would secure an ancient coat of arms for the city of Quebec. The Chesapeake was a United States frigate captured off Boston by the British frigate Shannon, and towed to Halifax in 1813. The sea duel became historic. 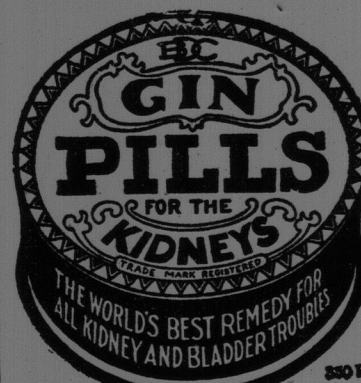

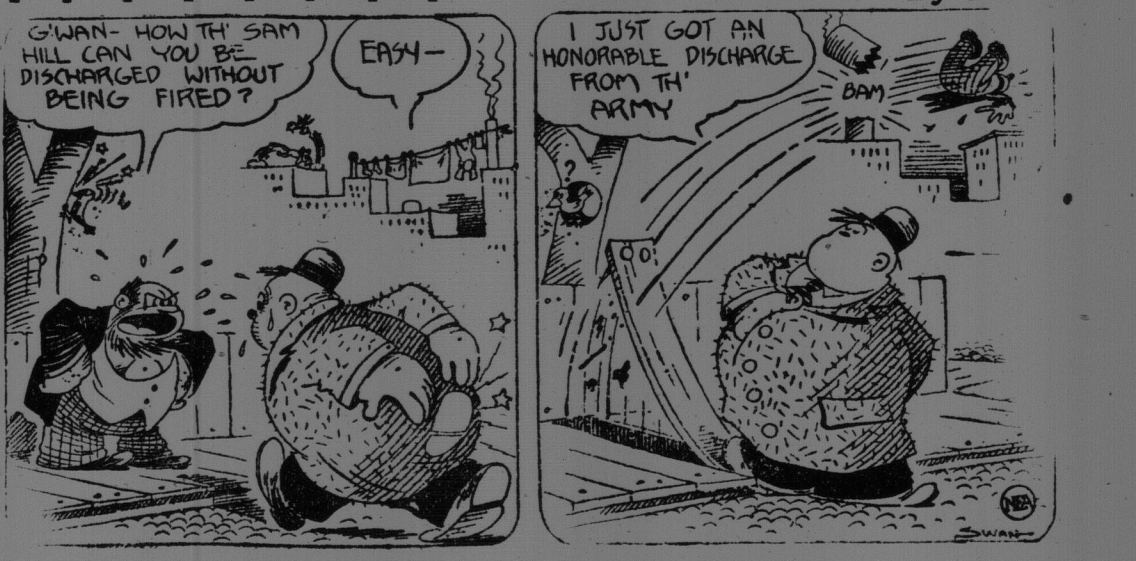
