LAWS AND REGULATIONS

Nova Scotia Bible Society.

This Society shall be called THE BIBLE SOCIETY OF NOVA SCOTIA AND ITS DEPENDENCIES; the objects of which shall be the same as that of the British and Foreign Bible Society, viz: to encourage the circulation of the Holy Scriptures, without note or comment, and to furnish copies of the Scriptures gratis to the indigent and at reduced prices to those requiring them.

The business of the Society shall be conducted by a President, Vice-Presidents, Treasurer, Secretary and Com-

III. In order to give effect to the designs of this Institution, benefactions and subscriptions shall be solleited, and books opened for receiving the names of benefactors and subscribers.

IV. Every person contributing annually Ten Shillings at one time or a donation of Ten Pounds, shall be considered a Member of the Society.

V. A General Meeting of the Members of this Society will be held every year, before which will be laid the accounts and proceedings of the preceeding year.

The whole of the subscriptions and donations, after deducting incidental expenses, shall be remitted anumally in aid of the funds of the British and Foreign Bible Society.

Every Member of this Society shall be entitled to purchase, under the direction of the Committee, Bibles and Testaments at the reduced prices of the Society, which are as low as

The Committee shall be authorized to meet for the VIII. purpose of conducting the business of the Society as often as may be necessary, and shall have power to add to their numbers as occasion may require.
